The tree has significant die-back but is not dead. It is very close to the copper beech and is growing in the canopy of this neighbouring tree. Its removal would not adversely affect the visual character of the conservation area but could possibly impact on the beech in terms of damage



from a prevailing wind from that direction. Hopefully the beech would put on growth on that side once the other tree was removed.
